

Oratorium (Oratory in English) (Church Latin , " chapeau " of Latin ORARE , "pray ") is a major musical work for orchestra , vocal soloists and chorus . The action of an oratorio is often restricted to a minimum. Some oratorios contain not a real story. In an oratorio 's narrative purpose not so much dramatic as aesthetic: the narrative is structured musical work and given importance.

A **laboratory** is a study room or a building that is used to engage in scientific research, experimentation and measurement under controlled conditions. The word derives from Latin and means working.


Oscillator is a mechanical, acoustic el. electrical system that creates fluctuations. Electrical oscillators are important parts of radio transmitters and receivers, and a variety of other electronic devices.


An oscillator may be an amplifier circuit in which one of the output signal goes back to the amplifier input but with a phase shift, causing feedback. The circuit often includes a


oscillating circuit with components that provide a specific frequency in various countries. [ORIGIN: from *Congregation of the Fathers of the Oratory*.]


